1. APPLICATION

- High School students outside Orange Unified School District <u>will have to apply online between</u> <u>March 1, 2010 and March 25, 2010</u>.
- Students must submit a valid email.

2. PLACEMENT TEST

- Students must complete the online application for eligibility to test!
- <u>After notification that the application has been processed</u>, the student can sign up for SCC placement testing on one of the following dates:

* Thursday March 4	3:30-6:30pm	* Tuesday	March 16	3:30-6:30pm
* Monday March 8	3:30-6:30pm	* Monday	March 22	3:30-6:30pm
* Tuesday March 9	3:30-6:30pm	* Monday	March 29	3:30-6:30pm
* Monday March 15	3:30-6:30pm	* Tuesday	March 30	3:30-6:30pm

- Students must bring SCC student ID number and any photo ID to the placement test.
- Call the SCC Outreach Department at (714) 628-4808 to sign up.

3. ORIENTATION

- Students must complete the SCC placement test before being allowed to attend the SCC college orientation.
- Students should bring with them an unofficial copy of their high school transcript.
- Students can sign up for one of the following SCC orientation dates:

* Friday	April 16	9am	Friday	April 30	9am
* Friday	April 23	9am	Friday	May 7	9am

- Parents who attend the orientation dates will <u>not</u> be allowed into the student orientations. There will be separate parent orientations during student orientation dates that parents can attend.

4. **REGISTRATION**

- Students will receive an email with their ONLINE REGISTRATION DATE & TIME.
- Students will register for open class sections. Students WILL NOT be able to go on the "WAITLIST" for any closed classes during their priority registration date.
- Students who MISS their priority online registration date will NOT be allowed to register until mid August.
