However this year we will be doing a different program: "Disney's Approach to Leadership and Teamwork" on <u>February 12, 2018</u>. The cost has increased to \$83 per student **but our PTSA** has graciously given us \$15 per student to offset the cost, so it is only <u>\$68</u>. Parking is not included in your cost, so please plan to pay an additional \$20 if you will be parking.

You must be a paid member (dues are \$16) in order to attend this event. If you would like to pay your dues, please see me or fill out a membership envelope located in the school's front office. For liability reasons, if you are not a member by the day of the event, you will not be able to attend.

We will participate in a Leadership class together put on by Disney for about 3 hours and then you get to hang out in Disneyland for the rest of the day. We will have at least 3 adult chaperones attending as well as myself but only during the program, which would be until about 1:30. At that point, if you stay at Disneyland, you will be on your own without a chaperone.

There is no school on February 12, so we'll meet at the park that morning (exact location and time to be decided but will be around 10 am) and you will need to be picked up at the park at the end of the day (the program will be done at approximately 1:30 pm but your park ticket will allow you stay in Disneyland until they close).

The course description is "Discover the Disney way of working and the management skills used to lead a Cast of thousands. Students in grades 6-12 will practice overcoming obstacles by working as a team and thinking creatively to develop solutions during this 3-hour program. Exercises designed to reinforce courage, curiosity and constancy aim to give students the confidence to set goals and accomplish their dreams."
